Qualifications and experience

- A good level of general education is required for this post.
- An industry qualification is also required, BHS stage 3 or equivalent.
- At least 5 years experience of working in an equine environment is essential, some of which should be at a supervisory level.
- Qualification and/or experience of basic equine first aid and wound management is desirable.
- Experience in health and safety is desirable.
- Qualified first aider desirable.
- Trailer driving licence desirable.

Knowledge and skills

- Proven supervisory experience and excellent communication skills.
- Knowledge of up to date equine welfare policies of best practise.
- The ability to maintain efficient and effective records.

Personal qualities

- Dynamic, with high level of motivation and initiative, with the ability to recognise opportunities for best practise and ensure highest levels of animal welfare.
- The ability to promote a professional image of the charity at all times, both in and out of work.
- Ability to inspire and motivate team members.
- Good communicator, including both verbal and written. The ability to communicate confidently at all levels of authority within the organisation.
- The ability to learn quickly and adapt to various situations.
- The ability to work on own initiative.
- Flexibility and willingness to work out of contracted hours when required.
